10 SAFETY TIPS FOR EVERY LOCATOR, EVERY JOB

It's not just what we say—it's what we do that keeps us safe. These 10 safety actions show your commitment to the job, your crew, and your community.

LEAD BY EXAMPLE. STAY SHARP. WALK THE TALK.

Drive safely to each locate.
Wear your seat belt. Never text
and drive.

Wear your personal protective
equipment. Clearly identify
yourself as a utility locator.

Scan for hazards that could
get you hurt, like drop-offs,
difficult terrain, or dogs.

For security, let someone know
when you arrive to and leave a
jobsite.

Know where your closest fire
extinguisher and first aid kit
are located.

Read the entire ticket and have
a full understanding of the dig
area.

Walk the jobsite to visually
inspect for signs of utilities
and identify other potential
hazards.

Check the prints and identify
all utilities & structures that
may conflict with the dig.

Take plenty of photos of the
dig area and status the ticket
correctly.

Before departing, perform
a 360-walk-around of
your vehicle & secure all
equipment.
